### Diamond Jubilee Fundraising Top 10

Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee, marking 60 years of reign, takes place in June 2012. Why not take advantage of this fantastic milestone and organise an event to raise funds for your nursery or school. We've put together our top ten tips and ideas.

1. In true British tradition, arrange a party to celebrate the Jubilee. This could be a street party where you fill trestle tables with food and hang bunting across the playground or it could be a children's party or disco. Whatever you decide, charge an entrance fee and have a tuck shop too – an easy and hassle free way to raise funds. If parents are coming along too, you could even hold a raffle on the day to raise some extra £££'s.
2. Get crafty! Why not organize your summer fair this year ahead of the Jubilee celebrations, and have a craft stall where the children pay to make bunting, flags and crowns to either wear themselves or use their creations as decorations and table settings to make your celebration party look royally beautiful at your nursery or school.
3. Get creative – children love to draw pictures so why not encourage them to draw pictures to commemorate the Jubilee and get them printed onto a range of souvenir products.
